I will be suggesting a few edits to our current format:

- 1. I'll be suggesting that we start our net taking check-ins from those who are mobile (outside in your car on the road mobiles) first as we may risk losing them if they go out of range.
- 2. We will take Short time (No Traffic) check-ins
- 3. We will take Portables, followed by Regular Check-ins

Last question – who does not have access to UHF? Quick show of hands. All in the room had dual band capability.

Dean suggested that we shorten the net by concentrating on the key repeaters (VE3SVC and VE3PGC) every Monday night and adding 2 more repeater from our bank of 8 on a rotating basis every Monday night. It was further suggested by Roger (VA3GBV) to add VA3FHA to the key repeaters to be exercised on every net, such that we cover all 3 SVARC repeater sites every Monday.

6- Technical Directors Report – Doug (VE3HTR):

The AIS receiver for Marine traffic is off-line and will be investigated on the next maintenance trip to the CCH site (Upon St-Lawrence Seaway opening date, planned for March 22nd)

VA3FHA repeater had experienced interference lately. However, it has been operating normally over the last two Net. No further action is planned at this time.

It is suggested that VE3VSW repeater be exercised more often, as it has the same wide coverage as VE3PGC and has Fusion capability.

Chris (VA3CRR) mentioned that we have received a tracking number from Yeasu for the new repeater ordered. Delivery is expected in March.

7- 2024 Year Planning:

a. Coffee Klatch venue

Motion to adopt the Best Western venue was carried by 10 votes for, 4 abstentions, 4 members did not vote.

c. Fox Hunt

I was proposed by Jason (VE3PRY) Seconded by Earnest (VA3HWV)

To purchase a new FOX: MicroFox PiCon from BYONICS at a cost of \$165 usd plus shipping. Requesting an approval of \$340cdn maximum expenditure.

After some discussion a vote was held:

1 for, 12 opposed, 1 abstention, 4 members did not vote.

Motion rejected.

d. Hamfest:

Hunter (VA3HWF) introduced a guest from the Prescott Russel Amateur Radio Club, Mickael Papineau (VA3PAI), to explain the proposed joint venture between PRARC and SVARC to hold a Hamfest on September 28 at the St-Albert Community Center.

John (VE2EQL) further explained that the idea is to invest \$1000, matching the PRARC investment, and sharing the profits equally.

John explained that the event would be breaking even with 228 attendees.

Proposed to proceed with committing \$1000 from the Club general fund by Hunter VA3HWF) Seconded by Dave (VA3OPS

Vote was held:

12 for, 1 against, 4 abstentions, 1 member did not vote.

8- By-laws revision

Article 2.1 of the SVARC bylaws states:

Bylaw amendments require approval of 50% plus one of the full members in good standing, of the Club who are present at the meeting at which the amendments are voted on.

This is not in line with the "Robert's Rules of Order".

Robert's Rules of Order article 56:50 stipulates:

56:50 **Article IX: Amendment of Bylaws**. The bylaws should always prescribe the procedure for their amendment, and such provision should always require at least that advance notice be given in a specified manner, and that the amendment be approved by a two-thirds vote. If the bylaws contain no provision for their amendment, they can be amended by a two-thirds vote if previous notice (in the sense defined in 10:44) has been given, or they can be amended by the vote of a majority of the entire membership.

It is proposed to amend article 2.1 as follows:

Bylaw amendments require approval by a two-thirds vote of the members present or by a majority of the entire membership.

Notice of amendments shall be given at the club meeting preceding the meeting at which the amendments are voted on.

Notice is being given at the January 31, 2024, meeting and was submitted to a vote at the February 28, 2024, meeting.

Motion to approve proposal: Roger (VA3GBV) Seconded: Hunter (VA3HWF) 14 for, none against, 4 members did not vote.

Motion carried.
